Graduating Seniors

Apply for FAFSA Now or Lose Tribal Funds For College

Important Deadlines for Lincoln/Tillamook County-area high school seniors who are going to college next year.

1. FAFSA deadline is Jan. 31, 2019. Submit your FAFSA application to, fafsa.ed.gov

2. Higher Education grant application or Adult Vocational Training deadline is June 30, 2019.

Please remember, you must submit your FAFSA application no later than Jan. 31, 2019, to be eligible to apply for Tribal education funds for the upcoming school year.

Contract Health Services

Are you a Tribal member?

You can get help with your medical bills if you participate in Contract Health Services (CHS). Follow these steps:

- 1) Update every year with the Siletz Community Health Clinic.
- 2) If you do not have any private health insurance, call our benefits coordinator at 541-444-9611 and we will help you sign up for no-cost health care coverage.
- 3) Call 800-628-5720 within 24 hours of any non-Indian health facility dental, optometry or medical appointments (even your labs) and get an authorization number. All visits require a separate authorization number.
- 4) Take your insurance cards and your authorization number to your appointments. Each appointment needs a different authorization number.
- 5) CHS can help pay your copays and patient responsibility if you follow these easy steps.

Should you go to the ER or the walk-in clinic?

Call 800-628-5720

A gatekeeper will help you 24 hours a day!

Did you have an emergency?

You have 72 hours to call CHS if you use the ER or an ambulance.

Are you going to see a specialist?

Have your doctor fax your request and chart notes to the CHS fax number – 541-444-9645 – by noon on Tuesdays.

Every Wednesday, the Gatekeepers meet and will approve or defer treatments.



Funded Orthodontic Treatment Screening



The 2019 Funded Orthodontic Treatment Program is fast approaching! All interested parties should contact the dental department to schedule a screening. The screening dates are April 17 and May 22, 2019.



The program and amount of accepted applicants will be dependent on the funding for the year. An additional screening date may be added if the need is great.

Applicants are selected by case severity, motivation of the patient and guardian, reliable transportation, routine dental checkups and the oral hygiene history of the patient, to name a few. We want the best results possible for the patient and thus place emphasis on these items in order to achieve this. The unbiased selection process is performed under the guidance of an orthodontic specialist and chosen through a committee.

Open to all ages who are **CHS-eligible only**. To be eligible for the 2019 program year, you must complete a screening appointment during one of the screening days. Each year's selection process is independent from previous years and does not carry over. Selected and treated individuals can only be selected once for the duration of the program. All applicants will be notified by mail if they have been chosen.

Please contact the Siletz Dental Clinic at 541-444-9681 to schedule an appointment. Individuals who have been placed on the waiting list will receive a postcard notifying them to call and schedule an appointment.
