#### Get on the Call List for Fresh Steelhead This Summer

The Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife will soon begin making fresh Siletz River steelhead available to the Tribe. These are whole hatchery steelhead caught by ODFW in the upper Siletz River fish trap. We usually get 2-3 hours advance notice the same day fish will be available.

An automated phone message system is used to notify call list participants of the day and approximate time fish will be distributed from the outdoor location near the administration building in Siletz.

Fresh steelhead are distributed per Tribal household on a first-come, first-served basis only (notes are not accepted).

Because mental health and relapse crises do not always happen during business hours, Siletz Behavioral Health has arranged a collaboration with an after-hours crisis line called Lines for Life.

On weekends and during the weekday hours of 5 p.m. to 8 a.m., the number to the Behavioral Health front desk is forwarded to Lines for Life, where you will be connected with a live mental health counselor. The counselor will do everything he/she can to help de-escalate, advise and support.

Afterwards, this information can be shared with our mental health counselor so follow-up care can be provided.
