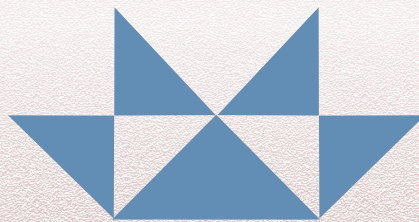



An Advance Care Directive is a legal document that allows you to communicate what type of life-sustaining medical care you would want if you were in the hospital and ever became unable to speak for yourself.

In other words, an Advance Care Directive is a set of instructions that express your health care desires if you are in a close-to-death medical condition and become incapable of letting others know what level of life-sustaining interventions you desire.
