I hereby certify that the information that I have provided accurately represents the total income for each member of my household (18 years and older). **I understand that I must report changes in household size or composition; increases in gross monthly income of more than \$100; changes in residence and/or address; when the household no longer incurs a shelter or utility expense; or a change in the legal obligation to pay child support to the Food Distribution Office within 10 calendar days after the change becomes known to the household.**
