At this time of year, the weather outside can be frightful. For the safety of all, we sometimes close our offices due to weather conditions.

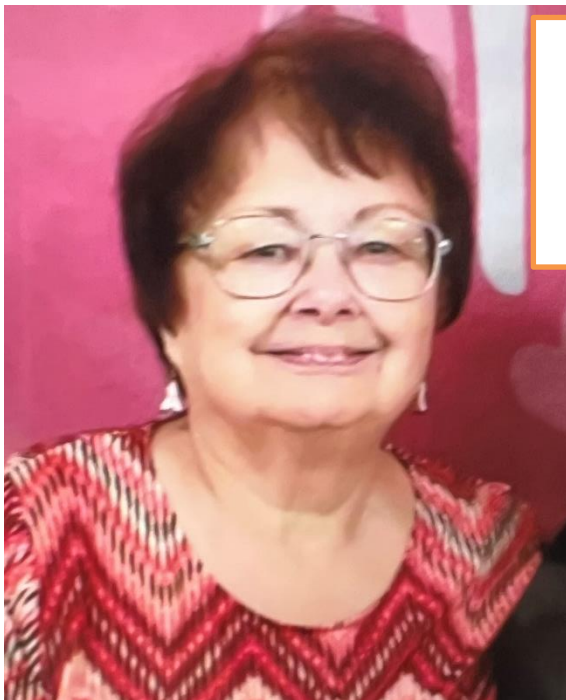
If it is snowing, icy or unusually cold, please call your Area Office *before* coming in, and listen to the message to make certain the office is open.

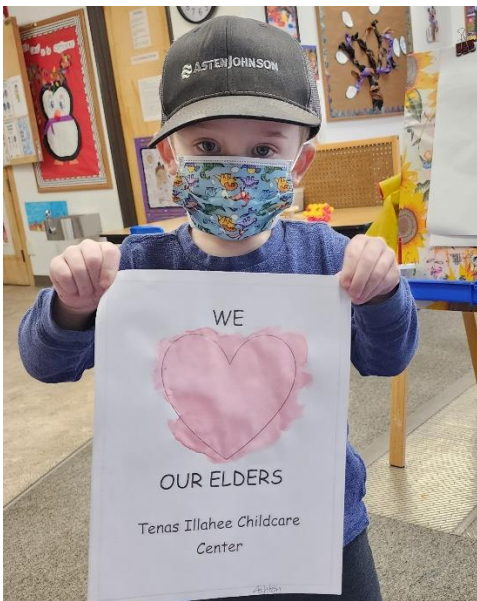
