**SUMMARY:** This notice is to advise interested parties that the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) as lead federal agency has approved a final Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the proposed action. **SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION:** Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians of the Siletz Indians of Oregon, through contractual obligations to the BIA, has proposed the Siletz Mixed Income Housing Development Project within Section 1, Township 7 South, Range 3 West: Willamette Meridian, Lincoln County, Oregon. The activities under the agency proposed action are the development of a Tribally owned 8.85-acre parcel to accommodate up to 40 mixed income housing units, a 3,000 square foot conference room, and adjoining offices. The activities will occur under guidelines outlined in the Siletz Mixed Income Housing Development Project EA.

**AUTHORITY:** This notice is published pursuant to 43 CFR 46.305 of the Department of Interior Regulations (43 CFR 46 et seq.), the procedural requirements of the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969, as amended (42 U.S.C. 4371 et seq.), and in accordance with the exercise of authority delegated to the Assistant Secretary – Indian Affairs by 209 DM 8.
