## Here is a recipe from our USDA usimg ingrediemts provided to our clients.

## MOHAWK INDIAN CORN SOUP

## INGREDIENTS

1. 1 Tablespoon oil or as needed
2. 2 chicken breast
3. 6 cups of water
4. 3 teaspoons Chicken bouillon
5. 3 teaspoons Beef bouillon
6.3 cups of cubed Carrots
6. 2 cups chopped Celery
7. 2 cans of canned Hominy, drained
9.1 can of kidney beans, rinsed and drained
8. Salt and Pepper to taste

Optional: Turnips cubed, Red Potato's and Cabbage sliced

## DIRECTIONS

Step 1
Heat oil in a large skillet over medium-high heat. Cook and stir your chicken cubed in hot oil till browned on all sides 5 to 10 minutes.
Step 2
Stir water, beef and chicken bouillon together in a large pot over medium -high heat until bouillon dissolves, add your chicken and vegetables, bring to boil, reduce heat to med-low and simmer until vegetable are tender, about 40 minutes.
Step 3
Stir in Hominy and Kidney beans into chicken-vegetable mixture and simmer until Hominy and meat are tender, about 30 more minutes. Taste and add your Salt and Pepper.
You can basically add whatever kind of vegetable you would like, canned or fresh.
Make up smaller hand sized fry bread to dip or butter with the Soup.
