Legal problems can be expensive, time consuming, and challenging. But, at no cost to you, we can help you manage legal issues that are standing in your way of safe, permanent housing.

We offer expert advice and services through our partnership with VA's new Legal Services for Homeless Veterans and Veterans At-Risk for Homelessness (LSV-H) grant program.

We are working hand-in-hand with VA to help Veterans like you access the resources you need to exit homelessness or housing instability.

How we can help

For Veterans living in Oregon, we're available to assist with:

- **Housing issues**, such as eviction defense or landlord-tenant and foreclosure cases
- **Family law**, such as child support, child custody, and divorce
- **Income support**, including obtaining public benefits
- **Criminal defense** in matters symptomatic of homelessness, such as fines, driver's license revocation or expunging or sealing a criminal record
- **Protective orders** and other legal matters related to domestic or intimate partner violence
- Other issues such as **access to health care or employment law**

Who is eligible

You are eligible for these services if you are a Veteran who is homeless or at risk for homelessness and needs assistance with any of the legal services authorized under the grant program.
